**External Review – Freedom of Information Act 1991 Michael Brown MP and Minister for Police, Emergency Services and Correctional Services**

I refer to the Ombudsman's determination made on 12 October 2020 regarding the external review of the Freedom of Information (FOI) application you made to my predecessor the Hon Corey Wingard MP under the Freedom of Information Act 1991 (the Act) requesting access to:

*"All documents (including but not limited to reports, briefings, emails, notes, minutes, plans and other documents) mentioning or related to the areas of Para Hills, Para Hills West, Parafield, Parafield Gardens, Mawson Lakes or Greenfields."*

I give effect to the Ombudsman's determination by issuing the following information.

On 29 July 2020, I was appointed by the Premier, Hon Steven Marshall MP, as the Minister for Police, Emergency Services and Correctional Services. The former Minister for Police, Emergency Services and Correctional Services, Hon Corey Wingard MP commenced responsibility for the Infrastructure and Transport portfolio and retained the Recreation, Sport and Racing portfolio.

I acknowledge that the former decision made by the previous office in the Review and Internal Review determination's to apply section 18 of the Act was undertaken as it was considered that the physical review of the high-volume correspondence for key words within scope, i.e. Para Hills, Para Hills West, Parafield, Parafield Gardens, Mawson Lakes and Greenfields, was an unreasonable use of resources. This is because the records management system does not register documents using suburb as a category, and therefore this would necessitate the physical review of all correspondence received during the date range within scope.

Following examination of the actions undertaken previously for this application, I am informed by my staff that searches of ministerial email accounts, network drives and the office's records management database, were undertaken, and accordingly 12 documents were identified which fall within my portfolio responsibilities.

As the Principal Officer of this agency and in accordance with the FOI Act please find enclosed the Schedule of Documents (attachment 1) and the documents for release (attachment 2).

I determine that two documents; 3 and 5 can be released in full.

Pursuant to clause 20(1)(b) access to documents 2 and 9 is refused, as the documents are publicly available. The website link to these documents is detailed in the schedule of documents. Section 20(1)(b) of the FOI Act provides that:

## **20- Refusal of access**

*1) An agency may refuse access to a document –*

*(b) if it is a document that is available for inspection at that or some other agency (whether as part of a public register or otherwise) in accordance with Part 2, or in accordance with a legislative instrument other than this Act, whether or not inspection of the document is subject to a fee or charge;*

I have determined that documents 1, 6, 7, 8, 10, 11 and 12 contain information that identifies individuals, the release of which would constitute an unreasonable disclosure of their personal affairs. This information falls within the definition of personal affairs under the FOI Act; therefore, the information is exempt by virtue of Schedule 1, clause 6(1).

Further, pursuant to clause 6(2) document 4 is considered exempt as it contains allegations or suggestions of criminal activity which has not been established by judicial process.

## **6—Documents affecting personal affairs**

*(1) A document is an exempt document if it contains matter the disclosure of which would involve the unreasonable disclosure of information concerning the personal affairs of any person (living or dead).*

*(2) A document is an exempt document if it contains allegations or suggestions of criminal or other improper conduct on the part of a person (living or dead) the truth of which has not been established by judicial process and the disclosure of which would be unreasonable.*

If you are unhappy with this external review determination you are entitled to exercise your rights of further external review with the Ombudsman SA. Alternatively, you can apply to the South Australian Civil and Administrative Tribunal (SACAT) online at [www.sacat.sa.gov.au](http://www.sacat.sa.gov.au) or by providing a copy of this decision to [sacat@sacat.sa.gov.au](mailto:sacat@sacat.sa.gov.au) or GPO Box 2361 Adelaide SA 5001. If you wish to seek a further review you must do so within 30 calendar days of receiving this external review determination.

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**RE: DRIVER BEHAVIOUR – MAWSON LAKES**

I refer to correspondence dated 5 March 2018, from the electorate office of the Hon. Susan Close MP on behalf of [REDACTED] regarding speeding vehicles in Garden Terrace and Yates Street, Mawson Lakes. A copy of this correspondence has been attached for your information.

SAPOL records indicate that there has been four Traffic Watch Complaints over the last 12 months of disobey school crossing on Garden Terrace. Over the same period there were no complaints relating to speeding vehicles on Yates Street. There were no collisions reported during the same period on either Garden Terrace or Yates Street.

Between 8 March 2018 and 15 March 2018, SAPOL's Road Policing Section were deployed to Garden Terrace and Yates Street to conduct speed detection and visible policing duties. As a result two expiations were issued for seat belt offences.

A member of the Road Policing Section has made numerous attempts to contact [REDACTED] however he is yet to respond to messages left on his phone and at his home address.

On 4 April 2018, SAPOL is conducting a Corporate Operation focusing on school drop off and pickup areas and Mawson Lakes Primary School will be one of those schools policed.

The Road Policing Section will continue to deploy patrols to Garden Terrace and Yates Street to actively police this location for illegal driving behaviour.

This matter was referred to SAPOL during the caretaker period, since this has now ceased this matter is referred to your office for progression of the attached draft response.

Thank you for your email dated 5 March 2018, to the former Minister for Police, on behalf of [REDACTED] regarding speeding vehicles in Garden Terrace and Yates Street, Mawson Lakes.

Your correspondence was received during the caretaker period when I was not the responsible Minister.

However, I am advised by South Australia Police (SAPOL) that their records indicate there has been four Traffic Watch Complaints over the last 12 months of 'disobey school crossing' on Garden Terrace.

I am further advised that over the same period, there were no complaints relating to speeding vehicles on Yates Street. Additionally, there were no collisions reported during the same period on either Garden Terrace or Yates Street.

Between 8 and 15 March 2018, SAPOL's Road Policing Section were deployed to Garden Terrace and Yates Street to conduct speed detection and visible policing duties. As a result, two expiations were issued for seatbelt compliance offences.

I understand a member of the Road Policing Section has made numerous attempts to contact [REDACTED] however at the time of my letter, he was yet to respond to messages left on his phone and at his home address.

SAPOL has reassured me they regularly conduct operations focusing on school drop-off and pick-up areas, with Mawson Lakes Primary School being one of the schools policed. The Road Policing Section will continue to deploy patrols to Garden Terrace and Yates Street to actively police this location for illegal driving behaviour.

I trust this information is of assistance and I thank you for raising this important matter.

**MINISTERIAL BRIEFING PAPER****SUBJECT: Shooting – Para Hills****BACKGROUND:**

On 21 March 2018, two victims in one vehicle and the offender in another vehicle were involved in a road rage incident in Para Hills. The offender allegedly produced firearm and fired a number of shots at the victims. The victims left the scene and reported the matter at a police station.

**RELEVANT POINTS:**

- The victims, both male adults did not sustain any injuries.
- The offender, a 31 year old male, has been arrested and charged with two counts of aggravated assault, acts to endanger life, possessing a firearm without a licence and failing answer questions under the firearms act. He was refused police bail.
- This matter is an on-going investigation. SAPOL can confirm that damage caused to the vehicle was consistent with gunshots.

I am writing to you on behalf of ourselves and of our Clients. Our current Client list include but are not restricted to the following Companies:

- Country Living Homes - North Moonta
  - Coast to Coast Homes - North Moonta
  - Selecta Homes - Burton
  - Summerplace Homes - Greenfields
  - Rivergum Homes - Edinburgh North
  - Allsteel Homes - Edinburgh North
  - EMAC Systembuilt Homes - Para Hills West
- We are a house transport company located in SA that delivers transportable buildings not only within SA but also to NSW, NT & VIC. The buildings we carry are generally 8.0m wide and require 2 SAPOL Escorts to assist us when in transit due to DPTI Permit/NHVR regulations.

Of late we have found it increasingly difficult to transport buildings due to the lack of SAPOL Escort Officers available to us. It is our understanding that this might be due to the Wind Farm and Solar Farm carriers monopolising the SAPOL Escorts within SA.

In the past we have been able to work on roughly 2-4 week availability of SAPOL Escorts but at this time we are being forced to wait up 6-8 weeks past the date requested by our Clients. This means our Clients (who construct the buildings) are having to tell their Clients their delivery has been delayed by up to 8 weeks. This naturally has a roll-on effect for data, electrical work, plumbers, carpenters, painters, earthworkers etc that are also required post delivery to finalise the transport process.

We are finding that this is having a negative impact on our business and the businesses of our Clients. If we cannot deliver the buildings within a timely manner, our Clients will lose their Clients and be forced to shut their doors. In our opinion, as it currently stands, there is potential for a significant risk to the entire House Transport Industry, and the follow on effect to the Construction and Housing Industries themselves.

I look forward to hearing from you in the near future in relation to how we might be able to come to some kind of solution.

For some years I have been writing to a prisoner at Mount Gambier Prison. When he first was incarcerated at Yatala the prisoner replied to my letters for a short period. His correspondence soon since seized and I would like to find out a reason.

Last Christmas I sent this man a parcel. On the advise of (former) MP Snellings office I sent the package to the prisoner, via the Department of Correctional Services, Adelaide. It contained only a calendar, a Peoples Friend Magazine and a block of crossword puzzles. The package came back without any explanation! I find this insulting.

When checking back with my MP's office, I was simply told that I have no right to even know, if the man was still alive! So for years, I may have been sending postcards, letters, and above parcel to a dead person?

All I am asking is for information about this prisoner, Mr. [REDACTED], at Mount Gambier Prison. Is he alive? Has he gone senile? Can he still read? Or does he not want to have anything to do with the outside world?

I am not a family member, but should this exclude me from having above questions answered? Even prisoners are human beings. They have rights too.

Further to my earlier email, I apologize for the grammatical errors. Please find these fixed below. My contact details are:

I also wish to update you on the events of yesterday, when I had to make no less than four phone calls for a patrol to have [REDACTED] removed off my property as he repeatedly loitered on & off, switched off my security camera, menaced the new boarder & his friend who had arrived & refused to leave when ordered by me (& several times also by Police) to do so.

My sister and I also attended the Elizabeth Police Station to make a report of the assaults on us both. This report was refused & it was implied to us that police reports were accusing us of threatening or hostile behaviour ON MY PERSONAL PROPERTY, WITHIN MY OWN HOME!

Two things stand out from this encounter:

1) We were again refused badge numbers of the police which attended in order to write up our stories to you all! Last time this happened to me was at the Salisbury Police Station some years ago. At that time, I was forced to attend then Mike Rann's electorate office for resolution & assistance & the receptionist required an explanation from the police station as to why I was DENIED MY ABSOLUTE AND LAWFUL RIGHT! The receptionist instructed me to immediately return to the police station as she had ensured that I would rightfully receive that information & she advised I could make a Police Complaint.

When I returned, I was met by the then Superintendent who gestured to me with his finger to come close. He gave me the requested badge numbers and grudgingly gave me the forms to make a formal police complaint. Then he whispered to me inviting me to enter an interview room. I was concerned about the ominous, hushed invitation, but I did as instructed. The Superintendent then proceeded to inform me - away from public eyes and ears - that if I made a formal complaint, the police report would come back asserting I was violent, aggressive & abusive to police. I left the room shaken and did not make any further report.

**MINISTER WINGARD, IS THIS THE SAME LEGACY YOU WANT TO LEAVE IN YOUR DEPARTMENT UNDER PREMIER MARSHALL'S TERM IN OFFICE (A BLIGHT REMAINING FROM THE PREVIOUS LABOR GOVERNMENT) OR WILL YOU ENSURE A SWIFT & SIGNIFICANT CULTURAL CHANGE WITHIN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT?**

2) My sister and I requested a copy of the purportedly adverse police report against us. **This was denied to us also.** With police reports made secret, how easy is it for a crooked police officer (in a CYA) to switch stories to stitch innocent people wanting & needing police protections? Should I assume the same threat

made by the Superintendent many years ago to now still stand; namely, if we make a Police Complaint, the story of the events which transpired will switch to ensure that we are the ones accused of violent & threatening behaviours & NOT A CONVICTED AND KNOWN VIOLENT CRIMINAL WHO WAS NEEDING TO BE REMOVED FROM MY PROPERTY AS A TRESPASSER!? [I was recently a juror on a trespassing matter and know this aspect of the law, which has not been applied by police in this matter!].

3) Whilst my sister and I were at the Elizabeth Police Station, ironically just as we were informed of the adverse police reports we should expect against us, a former Boarder phoned me to see that I was okay after the incident. I informed him of the Police response & he immediately offered to complete a sworn affidavit on my behalf, in my defense, to say how happy he was to stay with me & what a generous, kind & accommodating landlord I have been to him (even though he also had been behind on rent). This reminded of two text messages from two other boarders (see attached), demonstrating very clearly that I WAS NOT MALICIOUS OR MALEVOLENT TOWARDS ANYONE. **So, when dishonest police want to portray me in this light UNJUSTLY (& I FEAR EVEN MALEVOLENTLY, after I dared to set them straight on their absolute ignorance of the laws which were intended to protect homeowners like me) because they are the bully, I will not remain silent!** Indeed, I won't hesitate to push this to an ICAC (as advised on the Police complaints form) or other (e.g. Parliamentary) inquiry if I am forced to do so, but I would prefer a sincere & deep apology from one offending police officer who needs some serious retraining & a little law-schooling.

4) Since the original police report was made, I believe there is enough on record now to demonstrate who was the real aggressor on the night in question. Since finally removing his belongings last night, [REDACTED] has continued to contact me by texts & I have responded to say I will no longer respond directly to him over any matters he feels aggrieved or outstanding. Police have given him clear enough instructions on what to do hereafter.

5) When my sister and I were denied a police report two significant things happened:

- a) We were denied any opportunity to hold the offender accountable &
- b) his Correction Officer was herself hampered in her role to reform/rehabilitate her client or to ensure any "restorative justice". Rather, her client was just sent a message: "Thumb your nose at police & authorities & nothing will happen to you!". Way to go peoples! (I do wonder if the recalcitrant police officer who had it in for me might in some ironic twist eventually encounter the same criminal under less fortunate circumstances & how he would feel in that situation. Don't think for a minute he hasn't shared with his mates how hilarious it is to be able to make the police a laughing stock & if he gets locked up again, he will have an even more receptive audience).

**6) I will not be letting this matter rest as there are many thousands of vulnerable people in my situation who have & keep BOARDERS in their home for a range of economic & other reasons. I have vulnerable clients with boarders who help with domestic tasks to offset their lack of ability to care for themselves. Many parents still have adult children "board" with them under the exact same terms as [REDACTED] came to me. The very idea that a boarder can come in to anyone's home and then abuse them UNDER FULL PROTECTION OF THE POLICE IS REPREHENSIBLE AND UNCONSTITUTIONAL, wouldn't you all think so? I would hope so!**

**PREMIER, I would deeply appreciate a meeting to discuss STRONGER & UNEQUIVOCAL laws and regulations protecting landlords from BOARDERS WHO INTEND TO SQUAT & to limit police powers to ever try this stunt on anyone ever again, at your earliest convenience.**

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My humanitarian & charitable interests & community development & "entrepreneurial" skills have even been put to other uses. In the last three years, I have also formed the [REDACTED] seeks to assist disabled persons in the community through the arts, whilst giving local artists employment opportunities in this State. Our Board is made up of fine community members & I am confident they could all attest to my compassion, integrity, knowledge & skill when working with vulnerable persons **AND WE DO THIS WITH NO GOVERNMENT FUNDING OF ANY KIND.**

So, when my personal name & reputation is impugned by ignorant or indifferent public servants who don't know how to do their jobs in a proper, lawful, Constitutional & conscionable manner, I am most disturbed to find my hopes & aspirations crushed & my civil rights & liberties trampled.

So much so, that I now all too well understand why the public attitude to homelessness is one of indifference, contempt & disregard; but I don't blame the homeless person; I blame government authorities who won't do their jobs to protect people like me who take on the greatest risks - to ourselves and our families - in service of the community.

Tonight, I am writing regarding an incident at my home and property in Parafield Gardens, after I

was forced to call Police to assist with the eviction of a SQUATTER. Four officers attended three times over several hours.

## Background

For the past 18 months or so, I have been assisting homeless persons by providing very low cost and affordable housing whilst I am renovating my home & everything I do is fully disclosed to all relevant government agencies (e.g. ATO, Centrelink, etc..) & I make **no profit** from my endeavours. This has included many **high risk & vulnerable people** who would otherwise have had nowhere to live.

A comparison for you is this... I charge \$150/wk, with NO BOND, for a fully furnished room, including all facilities, appliances, utilities & unlimited internet. The next cheapest facility I have come across which is comparable to the clean & hygienic standards I insist upon, charges \$190/wk without internet & four weeks bond.

Meanwhile, I have had:

- My home trashed (with over 100 litres of urine stored in plastic milk bottles by one disturbed man- I have pictures!),
- Things stolen, from expensive kitchen items to computers, linen and everything in between,
- Boarders forge my signature on Centrelink documents for the purposes of fraud,
- Boarders refuse to pay rent & "do a runner" &
- Endured thousands of dollars in damage and clean up costs (never claimed on insurance as its not viable to do so).

Yet despite this, I have refused to give up on a dream I've had since childhood to assist the most vulnerable.... **until tonight (albeit I am not easily deterred)!**

In fact, I am well known across Facebook & other social media for taking on high risk persons & I am frequently "tagged" in posts from people desperate for a roof over their head (see attached evidence). City of Salisbury Mayor, Gillian Aldridge has even personally offered to assist my boarders with access to much needed services such as food & other welfare supports.

Before embarking on my project to assist homeless persons, I did some 24 months or more of research along with my sister, [REDACTED] (cc'd here). We even liaised with the Hutt St Centre & other homelessness service providers (including Centacare, Iris Property, etc...). We researched the laws of the State and Local Government Acts & Regulations, planning zones (City of Port Adelaide-Enfield, City of Salisbury, City of Playford & City of Torrens). We researched the State Residential Tenancies Act & a raft of others relating to hostels, rooming houses & the like. We even researched SQUATTING & what rights we might have if someone tried to do this to us when seeking to house a person without accommodation. I personally wrote to & consulted with Planners at the City of Salisbury & City of Playford regarding zoning & other issues & concerns.

This research led me to determine:

- 1) Local Government is/was supportive and encouraging of more affordable housing options for homeless & at risk persons (indeed, we were advised councils would "favour" applications from people like ourselves to support the homeless & low income earners).
- 2) As long as I kept a small operation & I still lived in the property which BY LAW means that I and/or my children were still occupying it (which we have been consistently during renovations), I was well within the law to treat the house as my home & to evict any person/s without a formal tenancy agreement.

When I decided to open my home to BOARDERS (NOT "TENANTS" with tenancy rights & entitlements), it was done on a very small, "experimental" scale (never more than two others at any one time). In actual fact, the home still prominently features my family photos & contains personal books, documents, linen, toiletries and other belongings of mine. It always has! Further, my son's room still displays a personal collection of hats.

To justify their non-intervention to assist my lawful eviction of a person threatening me with harm, Police even tried to assert that I did not reside at the house, even though **ALL Centrelink, Child Support, utility bills, my divers licence, passport, ASIC & other communications list me at the address and not at any other address.** I have however, been forced to temporarily rent another place to store belongings whilst I am renovating & building an extension to the property (I was even preparing to repair a large wardrobe & rip up carpets in my main room just before police arrived).

Tonight, my daughter & I found ourselves the unwitting victims of an attempt by a BOARDER, [REDACTED] (see documents attached) to squat after refusing to pay his rent (two weeks overdue) & then threatening me when asked to pay the agreed rent & to sign a formal Boarding Agreement. **This was the culmination of an all-day harassment campaign by the boarder, insisting by texts & phone calls that he could (effectively) live at my place for free!** In fact, he had a friend call to intervene on his behalf, but after detailed explanation of the situation & payments made & future payments owing, his friend made an agreement, which [REDACTED] quickly reneged upon.

**In an effort to intimidate me, [REDACTED] yelled & screamed at me & then began abusing me, calling me names & throwing insults - in my own home!** At that point I made clear he was no longer welcome in my home &, BY LAW, I was entitled to evict him immediately to ensure my safety & that of others who may have been in the house (as a new boarder moves in today). My daughter was present at this time & was noticeably distressed & I knew she was unsafe. [REDACTED] lives in one room in the house & pays \$200 board every week. [REDACTED] is at all times entitled to feel safe in her home & space.

When he refused to leave, I called the Police only to have them turn on me to have them then threaten, bully and intimidate me instead.

After three call outs & more than four hours, the boarder was finally compelled to leave (with eventually some commonsense prevailing) but not before a major neighborhood disturbance & my sister & I being assaulted within the house (caught on video). Needless to say, police refused to attend to my sisters report of her being assaulted when called & police claim they never witnessed anything, & they even tried to suggest we had been aggressive, hostile, angry, blah, blah, blah... whilst telling me that my daughter, my sister and I had to vacate MY own premises (thereby, tacitly giving the boarder tenancy rights; which I refused to do or acknowledge by such actions; & ignoring [REDACTED]'s right to remain in her place in safety & peace having paid her board in full).

During [REDACTED]'s eviction, we uncovered a document detailing a long list of criminal offences for which [REDACTED] had recently served jail time, including assaults, damage to property & carrying offensive weapons. **When it was discovered how dangerous he is, the first officers were not interested in reading it & this was caught on their camera! They flatly refused to even acknowledge the document as if it were of no consequence. Indeed, it was not a concern to them because it was not their home or their family.**

During our efforts to evict [REDACTED], I switched off the power and water to the house & entered the room to take back possession of my property. In incident, in the dark, [REDACTED] attempted to reach for a weapon & then lunged across my sister to snatch her phone, causing her to trip and

fall. When police entered the home & shone a light a butter knife was found on the floor, which had fallen in the scuffle, but had not been there when police were present earlier. When my sister and I drew attention to the butter knife, the police officer looked down, stepped on it and denied seeing it there. Later, **most suspiciously**, during a clean up of the room, we actually found a hammer located in [REDACTED]'s toiletries drawer - **THE ONLY TOOL IN [REDACTED] POSSESSION** - no screwdrivers, wrenches, nuts, bolts, nails or other construction tools; no car parts or building materials!

Also during the many hours of police presence, my daughter, my sister and I were told by police repeatedly that we had no rights in my home (& they treated us accordingly) but alleged that the boarder had "tenancy rights" - **WITHOUT ANY LAWFUL PROOF OF THIS CLAIM!** Tenancy rights are not IMPLIED; they must be ACTUAL (i.e. written agreement!); but **BOARDERS HAVE NO TENANCY RIGHTS UNDER LAW. MY HOME; MY RULES! THAT IS THE LAW!**

Of course, the same officers who attempted to insist we leave also often recanted & resiled from that position when pressed & challenged by us about their knowledge of laws to protect us in our own homes (e.g. the boarder was NOT PROTECTED FROM IMMEDIATE EVICTION BY ANY TENANCY AGREEMENT & my CONSTITUTIONAL rights stood in that place), but it sticks in my craw to know that when I needed help, the police acted as a hostile entity.

To be fair, only one police officer in particular was in my view overtly hostile & antagonistic towards me whilst, most to my distress, one officer finally stood up to [REDACTED] who breached police directions to remain outside the house & not re-enter. This officer didn't hesitate to protect me & my property - leaving him visibly shaken & he did say as much. **For that I thank the officer & his lovely female partner who tried to reason with me despite my distress (neither of whose details I obtained).**

This morning I phoned [REDACTED] Corrections Officer, "Helen", who was most concerned by the events of last night & she insisted that my sister & I should be making a report to the police about the assaults against us both which took place & that she was most surprised to know that police did nothing to defend our rights not to be intimidated, threatened or harassed on **MY PROPERTY.**

**Now for the real kicker... It appears [REDACTED] is not even an Australian citizen!**

**MR DUTTON, WHY IS THIS MAN STILL HERE & WHY WAS HE ALLOWED INTO AUSTRALIA????**

**MINISTER WINGARD, WHAT WILL CORRECTIONS OFFICERS NOW DO TO ENSURE THAT [REDACTED] IS AGAIN BEHIND BARS TO SERVE OUT HIS FULL SENTENCE & WHAT TRAINING WILL POLICE RECEIVE TO PROTECT PROPERTY OWNERS SEEKING TO ENFORCE THEIR LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING CHARGING OFFENDERS?**

Minister Wingard, I will ATTEMPT later today to again make a formal police report of the assault on myself; as caught on video last night. I will hope this time police will not again refuse. I would hope it is my lawful RIGHT to make such a report, but I also know from past experiences that theory & practice are rarely reconciled in his manner. I will do so in the hope the Corrections Department will not unwittingly place or permit [REDACTED] to locate himself with another landlord similarly vulnerable. His next victim will not be so lucky.

Minister Wingard, we see all over the globe evidence of Police turning on property owners to Islamist thugs like [REDACTED], just as it was done in Kosovo. Is this how SAPOL is now being directed to now operate? Is this a policy directive? If so, when was this directive issued and by whom?

**PREMIER, SHOULD I NOW LOOK TO GIVE UP HOUSING HOMELESS PERSONS FOR GOOD, OR MIGHT YOU CONSIDER TOUGHER LAWS TO PROTECT PROPERTY OWNERS WHILST OFFERING US SOME INCENTIVES TO KEEP SUPPORTING OUR COMMUNITY?**

In closing, whilst there is much, much more to this story which is troubling & which I have not detailed herein, I pray that you might all offer me (& my sister cc'd here) the comfort & expressions of concern which I know I would never receive under Jay Weatherill's government.




