

Face-to-face domestic visit restrictions

From 28 May 2022

Domestic visitors aged 5 and above and prisoners must have received at least two doses of a COVID-19 vaccine. Visit bookings will commence on Monday 23 May 2022.

- 1 adult and 2 children visitors per prisoner
- Visitors aged 5 and above MUST show proof of valid vaccination (two doses) upon entry
- Visitors aged 12 and above are required to administer a Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) and provide evidence of negative result prior to entry into the prison
- Visitors aged 12 and above and prisoners must wear surgical masks at all times during the visit. Children aged 12 and under are encouraged to wear a mask
- Visitors and contractors deemed a close contact are not permitted to enter a prison
- Physical distancing of 1.5 metres encouraged
- Reduced number of tables available for social distancing – measured as per density limits at each institution
- Visit times determined by institutional requirements
- No food allowed
- No face-to-face visits allowed for prisoners in 7-day quarantine
- Virtual visits still available by Zoom/iPad.
