

Recommencement of face-to-face domestic visits

From 16 October 2021

Domestic visitors and prisoners must have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine.

Visit bookings will commence on Monday 11 October.

Reduced number of tables available for social distancing – measured as per density limits at each institution

Safety measures apply:

- 1 adult visitor (plus children) per prisoner
- Visitors over the age of 12 and prisoners must wear surgical masks at all times during the visit
- Visitors **MUST** show proof of at least one dose of a vaccination at the institution upon registration
- Children over the age of 12 **MUST** show proof of at least one dose of a vaccination at the institution upon registration
- No face-to-face visits allowed for prisoners in 14-day quarantine
- Prisoner and visitors must sit at least 1.5 meters apart
- No food allowed
- Visit times determined by institutional requirements
- Limited physical contact
- QR check in is required at nominated location

Virtual visits still available by Zoom/iPad.

From 13 November 2021, ALL domestic visitors and prisoners must be fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
